
After the sightseeing, enjoy a cable car ride all the way up to Mount Srđ from where you'll soak up magnificent views of Dubrovnik and its surroundings.


DUBROVNIK - KORČULA ISLAND

Korčula, the sixth largest Croatian island, extends across 20 miles in length yet it is rather narrow between 4 and 5 miles wide on average. This island is known for its dense, lush forests, resulting in being called "Black Korčula" (Kerkyra melaina) by ancient Greeks.

The island's principal towns include Korčula Town, referred to as "Little Dubrovnik" due to its medieval squares, churches, palaces, and charming houses. Other notable towns are Vela Luka and Lumbarda. Additionally, for those seeking a more secluded and tranquil escape, the island is dotted with smaller towns and villages, each offering a unique haven for leisure and exploration.

Wander through its narrow-cobbled streets, surrounded by 13th-century walls, or simply enjoy one of the many art exhibitions and summer evening festivals.

KORČULA - BRAC ISLAND




After the tour of Korcula, continue to Brac island.

The island is renowned for its stunning Golden Horn Beach in Bol, known as one of Croatia's most iconic beaches. It's a haven for water sports enthusiasts, offering ideal conditions for surfing, diving, and windsurfing due to the gentle breeze and perfect climate.

The town of Bol offers a serene setting, ideal to unwind by the charming harbor or venture to Vidova Gora for breathtaking views of the surrounding Adriatic islands. When on this magnificent island, be sure to explore its notable attractions: Pucisca with its Stonemasonry School, the historic village of Skrip, and the intriguing Brač Native and Olive Oil Museum.

BRAČ OLIVE MUSEUM VISIT & TASTING WITH HOMEMADE OLIVE OIL

Embark on a scenic journey through Brač inland, heading toward the charming village of Škrip, the oldest and one of the most popular villages on the island. Meander through its historic streets and pay a visit to the Museum of Olive Oil, a tribute to Brač's olive oil-making legacy, established back in 1864.

The Museum of Olive Oil showcases the traditional process of olive oil production on the island. It features a collection of historical tools and equipment such as the olive mill, press, screw spindle, transport bags, and tools for the production and storage of olive oil.

Additionally, the museum displays artwork by academic painter Hana-Marta Jurčević Bulić and sculptures by master sculptor Đani Martinić, providing an engaging portrayal of workers within the oilery. Indulge in a tasting of various olive oils and authentic local dishes rooted in the Mediterranean diet. The delectable array includes black and green olive patés, salted black olives, as well as bitter orange or fig jam, Brač cheese, Dalmatian smoked prosciutto, and salted anchovies.

Following this interesting experience, savor a traditional homemade lunch at a rustic estate, immersing yourself in a wonderful atmosphere and enjoying delightful local cuisine. Bon appétit!

SIGHTSEEING UNESCO CITIES: SPLIT & TROGIR

Discover two historical and scenic highlights of the Croatian coast during this halfday private tour guided by a local expert.

Begin in the city of Split, where you'll step back in time to discover the remarkable palace built by Emperor Diocletian in the 3rd century. Immerse yourself in this living museum, where the palace is still home to locals. With your guide, venture through this lively city, exploring its key landmarks such as Peristyle Square, Cathedral of Saint Domnius, Jupiter's Temple, Statue of Grgur Ninski, Prokurativa - Republic Square, Riva - Split waterfront, Piazza - People's Square, Varoš - Old Split's suburb, and many more.

Afterward, take a short drive to the wonderful islet of Trogir. Wander through this medieval city, where history comes to life in the presence of its historic landmarks. At the heart of the city stands the awe- inspiring Cathedral of St. Lawrence, showcasing an extraordinary portal designed by a prominent Dalmatian architect.

With a history spanning over 2,300 years, Trogir boasts an impressive display of well-preserved Romanesque, Gothic, Baroque, and Renaissance architecture, and artwork, influenced by ancient Greeks, Romans, and Venetians. Explore the most iconic attractions of this UNESCO Heritage town such as the Cathedral of St. Lawrence, Waterfront Promenade, Cipiko Palace, Kamerlengo Castle, St. Mark's Tower, The Clock Tower, and City Loggia, along with The City Gates.

SPLIT - ISLAND OF HVAR

After Split and Trogir, sail to island of Hvar.

Often referred to as the crown jewel of the Croatian Dalmatian islands, Hvar's fame stretches back to ancient times due to its strategic nautical position, natural wonders, as well as rich historical and cultural tapestry. With mild winters and pleasant summers, Hvar's shores beckon numerous visitors, including scientists and explorers who are drawn by its lush Mediterranean flora, cultural heritage, exquisite architecture, and vibrant nightlife. Hvar stands as Croatia's most vibrant island, catering to every type of traveler.





SPLIT - HVAR ISLAND WINE TASTING WITH TRADITIONAL LUNCH WITH LOCAL FAMILY

This private half-day wine tour will take you on a journey through centuries-old vineyards on Hvar Island. Guided by a local expert who will breathe life into the wines and unveil Hvar's rich vinicultural story, your journey begins in the historic Hvar town before you venture inland.

As you drive through the old villages of Brusje and Velo Grablje, you'll pass by many lavender fields that grace the landscape. The first stop is at Ager (Hora), a UNESCO-protected agricultural area, dating back to Greek times. A true masterpiece that has remained almost intact for 2400 years.

Next stop is Jelsa, where one specially chosen winery is waiting for your arrival. We're taking you back to the roots, to pure tradition: the Duboković winery, known for its award-winning red wines, including the celebrated Croatian wine, Medvid. Here, you'll enjoy these fine wines alongside homemade bread and local cheese in the intimate ambiance of a candlelit cellar in the winemaker's family house. Pure wine heaven!

To add to the pleasure, you'll have the opportunity to savor the family's own delicately flavored olive oils. Try basil or sage-flavored varieties, and you may decide to move to Hvar permanently. After the wine tasting, you'll head to the old, abandoned village of Malo Grablje for a fabulous traditional lunch.



PELJESAC PENINSULA - ELAFITI ISLANDS - DUBROVNIK

Starting from Peljesac, you embark on a voyage through the Peljesac Channel, flanked by lush green hillsides and dotted with charming coastal villages. The channel provides a relatively sheltered passage, offering smooth sailing conditions for most of the journey.

As you sail southward, you'll gradually catch sight of Dubrovnik's iconic cityscape on the horizon. The approach to Dubrovnik is particularly breathtaking, as you witness the ancient city walls rising majestically from the crystal-clear waters of the Adriatic.

As you approach Dubrovnik, pass Elafiti Islands - perfect spot for swim stop. The Elafiti Islands, also known as the Elaphiti Islands or the Elaphites, are a stunning archipelago situated just northwest of Dubrovnik along the Dalmatian coast of Croatia. This picturesque cluster comprises several islands, with the three largest and most visited being Šipan, Lopud, and Koločep.

Upon entering the port of Dubrovnik, you are greeted by the imposing forts and bastions that guard the city's maritime entrance. The Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, beckons with its labyrinthine streets, historic churches, and bustling squares. Moor your boat in the marina or anchor in the bay, and then venture ashore to explore Dubrovnik's timeless beauty and vibrant culture.


